Dear Representative Perry:

We, the four Indivisible groups in the PA-10<sup>th</sup> Congressional District, are profoundly disappointed by your dismissive comments about the establishment of an impeachment inquiry into the actions of the President of the United States. Credible allegations of abuse of power by Donald Trump in his dealings with the President of Ukraine compel this inquiry. Your serious and principled review is vital to fulfill your Oath of Office, in which you pledged to “preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States.”

We urge that you thoroughly read the enclosed documents, which clearly detail the issues and specific actions that compel this inquiry:

Because of the significance of these documents, we cannot sufficiently stress that you personally read them and not rely on staff or others to summarize or interpret them for you.

We also urge you to read the materials with a mind open to the facts and credible assertions they contain. We remind you that, as a Member of Congress, you are bound by your oft-stated commitment to the Constitution and its implied adherence to the rule of law. Allegiance to party and ideology cannot supercede these obligations.

- The President DID ask a foreign government to “do [him] a favor.”
- That favor WAS to investigate a rival politician.
- The President DID withhold aid that had been promised to the Ukraine to compel agreement.
- The purpose was to benefit the President in the upcoming election.
- Over 300 National Security professionals agree that impeachment proceedings are justified and necessary: *“If we fail to speak up—and act—now, our foreign policy and national security will officially be on offer to those who can most effectively fulfill the President’s personal prerogatives.”*

Your concerns that this inquiry will dissuade the House from acting on critical legislation are unfounded. The House of Representatives, under the new Democratic majority, has already passed more than 100 bills, including health care legislation protecting those with pre-existing conditions, expansion of voter rights and protections to assure election integrity, reasonable laws to reduce gun violence, and reauthorization of the Violence Against Women Act. Each of them now languishes in the Senate, where Senator Mitch McConnell has refused to act on any of them.

This President’s actions require serious scrutiny to determine if they meet the criteria for “high crimes and misdemeanors.” If so, and we believe they do, they warrant impeachment in the House, trial in the Senate, and ultimately removal from office.

Fulfill your obligation to your country and your constituents. Place country before party and ideology and decide for yourself re impeachment based on facts and evidence.
